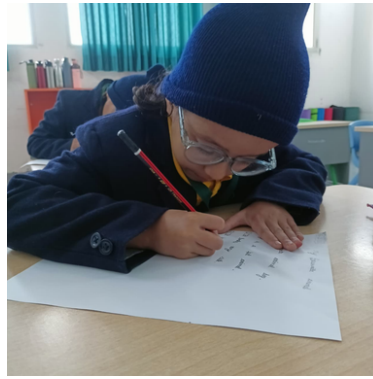
CREATIVE WRITING ACTIVITY

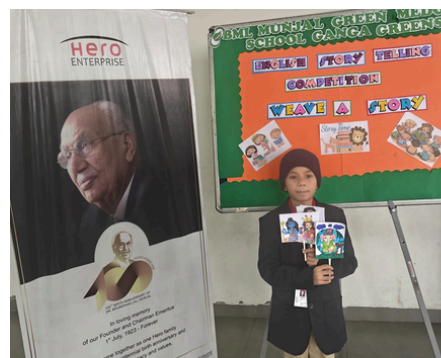


WEAVE A STORY

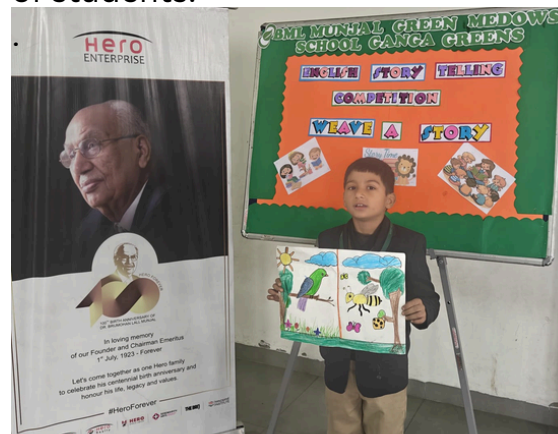
February 5, 2026

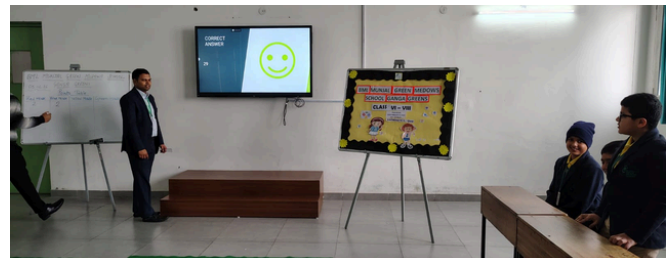
MATHEMATICS QUIZ

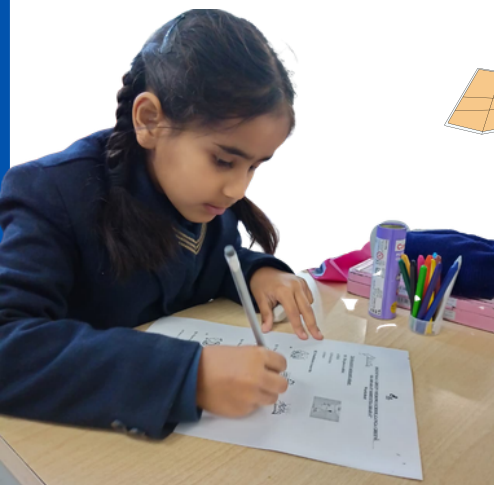


EK BHARAT SHRESHTHA BHARAT

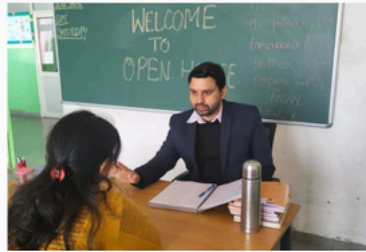
Students participated enthusiastically as customers and learned to identify currency, count money, ask prices, and make payments.

February 17, 2026

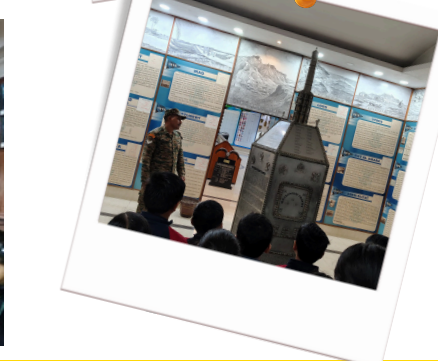

18 February, 2026



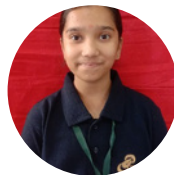
